ATTENDED FUNERAL (funeral director's charges only) This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the same time as the their burial or cremation.	£2,670 y attend

Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death, within 15 miles of our premises, into Hadaway & Denton's care	£200

Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer)	£100
At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 20 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate funeral vehicle (hearse options available at request)	£660

UNATTENDED FUNERAL

This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.

Burial (funeral director's charges only)	£1,095
Cremation (funeral director's charges plus the cremation fee) ²	£1,320

FEES YOU MUST PAY

For an attended or unattended burial funeral, the **burial fee.**¹

In Ashford, Kent the typical cost of the burial fee for the local residents is:

For a new grave, you will also need to pay for the plot; for an existing grave with a memorial in place, you may need to pay a removal/replacement fee. In addition, the cemetery may charge a number of other fees.

For an attended cremation funeral, the **cremation fee.**²
